Please be prepared for the following requirements:

- 1 BLUE CARD PARKING** may be available on site. **NO OTHER PARKING PERMITTED.**  
Please use the Swan Centre Multi-Storey, Leret Way, KT22 7HP.
- 2 Doors open at 12.10.** Please queue safely distanced. First come first served.
- 3 Be prepared to be turned away** once all the safe seating has been allocated.  
No exceptions, not even for late-running transport, difficulty parking, etc.
- 4 Test & Trace:** You must give us your name, address, & phone no, *write out before you leave home & hand us the paper*, or use QR code displayed at LMC.
- 5 You must wear a face-covering**, unless exempt.
- 6 Stewards will allocate seats** on a first come, first served basis. You may sit as a "bubble", eg neighbours together, family, all in the same car, if you feel it is wise.
- 7 If you use Church toilets** cleaning instructions will be given (best to go at home)
- 8 Unfortunately, we cannot offer refreshments yet.**
- 9 Stewards will tell you when you should leave your seat.** Maintain spacing as you leave. Please do not break your bubble by chatting outside without a mask.
